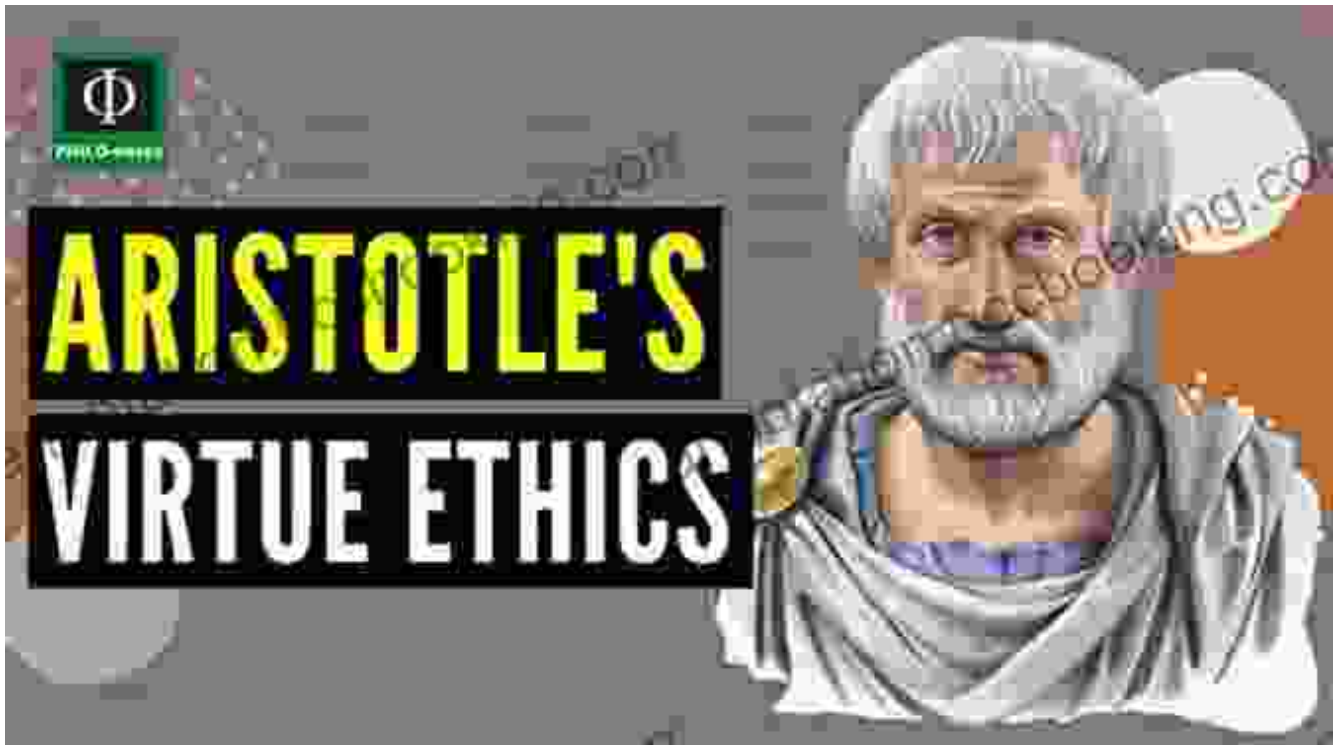

- The core of this definition is the notion of "resulting of necessity" (*ex anankês sumbainein*). This corresponds to a modern notion of logical consequence: "If this occurs... then this must be the result"

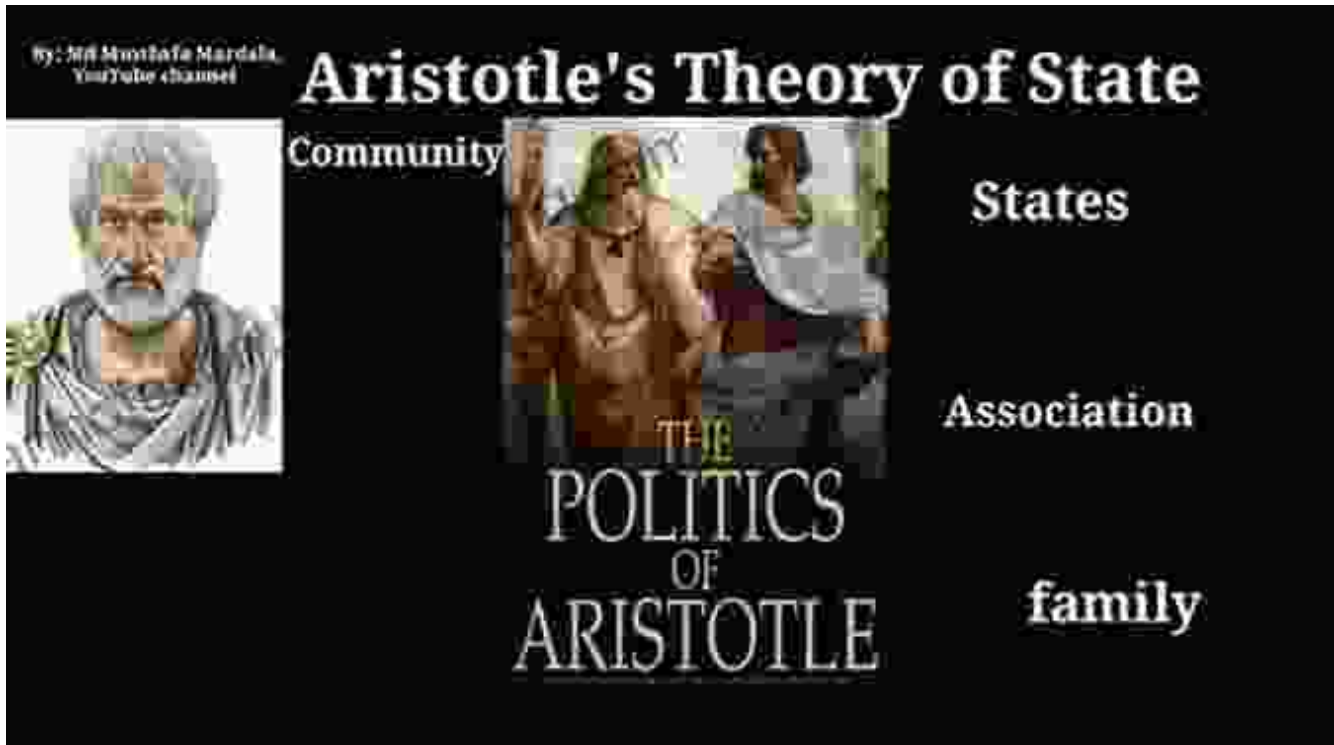

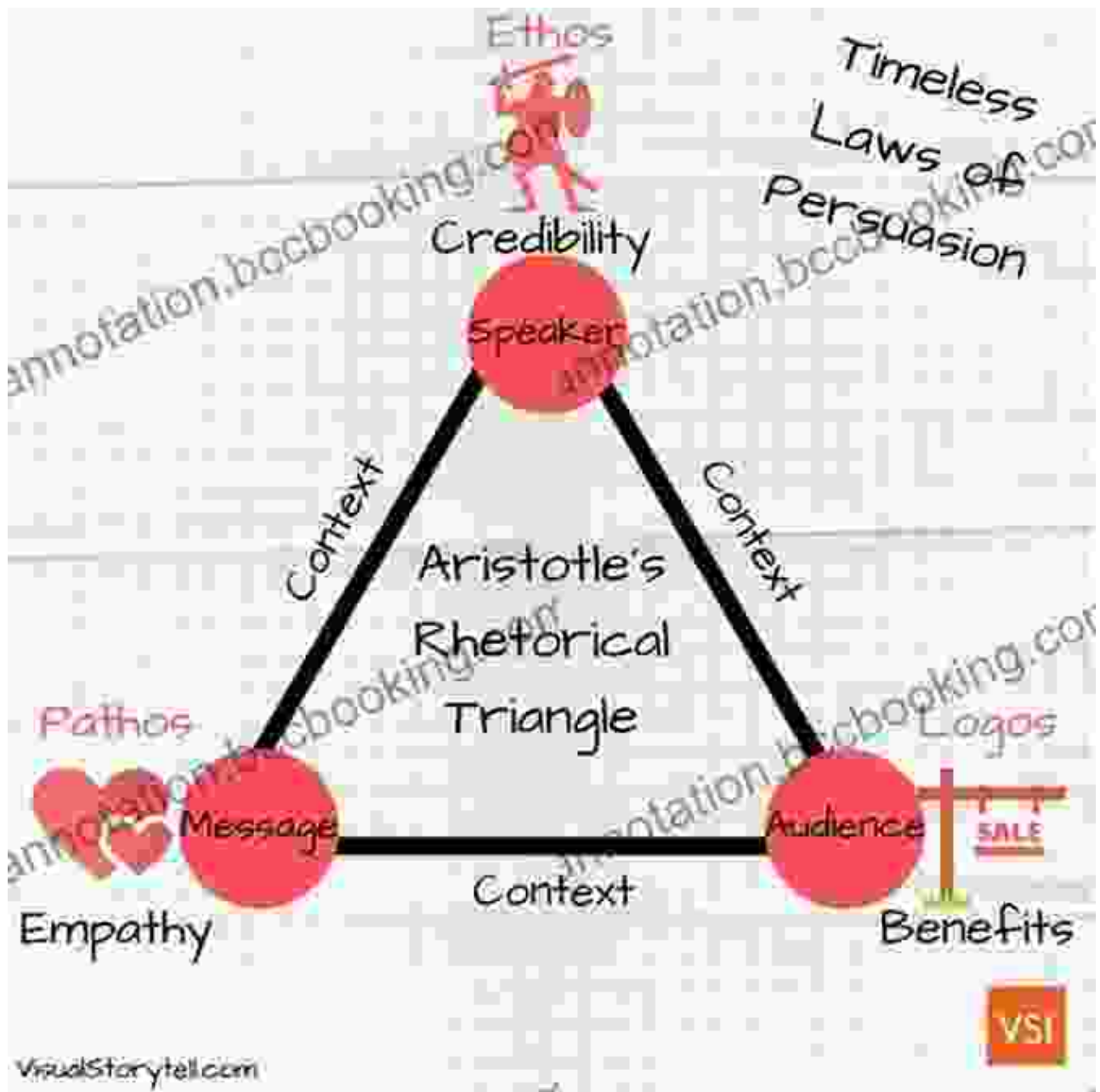

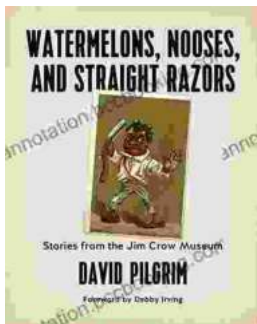
