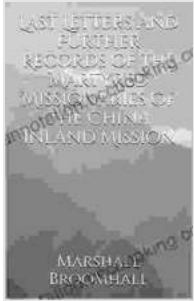

## **Author Biography**

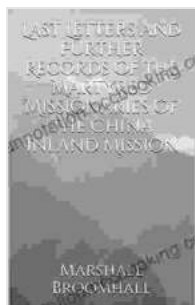
